Gen 47:15 So when the money failed in the land of Egypt and in the land of Canaan, all the Egyptians came to Joseph and said, "Give us bread, for why should we die in your presence? For the money has failed." NKJV

WHERE TO LIVE IN THE END TIMES

Do Christians have to be a target and bear with the rest of the world when judgment comes upon the nations that they live in?

The children of Israel were a nation within a nation when judgment came upon Egypt.

1 Peter 2:9-10. 9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

REMEMBER WHERE YOUR LEGAL CITIZENSHIP IS.

Phil 3:20-21. 20 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

Eph 2:18-21. 18 For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father. Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone,

Heb 12:22-24. 22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, 23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, 24 to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.

THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL WERE A NATION WITHIN THE NATION OF EGYPT, AND THEY LIVED IN GOSHEN.

JOSEPH WAS SOLD INTO SLAVERY BY HIS BROTHERS. Gen 37-Gen 46.

Gen 46:28-34. 28 Then he sent Judah before him to Joseph, to point out before him the way to Goshen. And they came to the land of Goshen. 29 So Joseph made ready his chariot and went up to Goshen to meet his father Israel; and he presented himself to him, and fell on his neck and wept on his neck a good while. 30 And Israel said to Joseph, "Now let me die, since I have seen your face, because you are still alive." 31 Then Joseph said to his brothers and to his father's household, "I will go up and tell Pharaoh, and say to him, 'My brothers and those of my father's house, who were in the land of Canaan, have come to me. 32 And the men are shepherds, for their occupation has been to feed livestock; and they have brought their flocks, their herds, and all that they have.' 33 So it shall be, when Pharaoh calls you and says, 'What is your occupation?' 34 that you shall say, 'Your servants' occupation has been with livestock from our youth even till now, both we and also our fathers,' that you may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd is an abomination to the Egyptians."

GOSHEN AT THE TIME OF MOSES.

Ex 1:8-10. 8 Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. 9 And he said to his people, "Look, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we; 10 come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and it happen, in the event of war, that they also join our enemies and fight against us, and so go up out of the land."

Ex 1:11-14. 11 Therefore they set taskmasters over them to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh supply cities, Pithom and Raamses. 12 But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were in dread of the children of Israel. 13 So the Egyptians made the children of Israel serve with rigor. 14 And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage — in mortar, in brick, and in all manner of service in the field. All their service in which they made them serve was with rigor.

THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL WERE TERRIBLY OPPRESSED, BUT STILL HAD LIVESTOCK AND MAYBE EVEN GARDENS AND CROPS.

GOD PLACED PROTECTION AROUND GOSHEN SO THAT THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL WERE NOT TOUCHED BY THE PLAGUES, HE SEVERED THEM FROM THE EGYPTIANS.

OT:6395 palah (paw-law'); a primitive root; to distinguish (literally or figuratively): KJV - put a difference, show marvellous, separate, set apart, sever, make wonderfully.

Ex 8:22 And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms of flies shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I am the LORD in the midst of the earth. KJV

Ex 9:4 And the LORD shall sever between the cattle of Israel and the cattle of Egypt: and there shall nothing die of all that is the children's of Israel. KJV

Ex 9:25-26. 25 And the hail smote throughout all the land of Egypt all that was in the field, both man and beast; and the hail smote every herb of the field, and brake every tree of the field. 26 Only in the land of Goshen, where the children of Israel were, was there no hail. KJV

Ex 10:22-23. 22 And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days: 23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings. KJV

Ex 11:7 But against any of the children of Israel shall not a dog move his tongue, against man or beast: that ye may know how that the LORD doth put a difference between the Egyptians and Israel. KJV

WE ARE A NATION WITHIN A NATION, THAT MEANS WE HAVE DUAL CITIZENSHIP. WE ARE DIFFERENT THAN THE PEOPLE IN THIS WORLD, BECAUSE OF GOD'S PRESENCE THROUGH OUR NEW BIRTH EXPERIENCE.

Ex 33:15-16. 15 Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here. 16 For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? So we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth." NKJV

GOD WILL JUDGE THE god's OF THIS DAY AND AGE JUST AS HE DID IN EGYPT.

Gen 15:12-14. 12 Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and behold, horror and great darkness fell upon him. 13 Then He said to Abram: "Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years. 14 And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward they shall come out with great possessions.

Ex 12:12b and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

HOW LONG THE PLAGUES TOOK WE DO NOT KNOW, SOME WEEKS OR A FEW MONTHS, BUT PROBABLY NOT A LONG TIME,

1. The waters of Egypt. Ex 7:19-25.
2. Frogs. Ex 8:1-15
3. Lice or gnats. Ex 8:19
4. Insects, flies. Ex 8:20-32
5. Pestilence. Ex 9:1-7
6. Boils that brake out in sores. Ex 9:8-12
7. Hail. Ex 9:17-35
8. Locusts. Ex 10:1-20
9. Darkness. Ex 10:21-29
10. Death of the Firstborn. Ex 11:1-12:30

THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL, THE CITIZENS OF GOSHAN, DID NOT RECEIVE THE JUDGMENTS OF GOD.

They had water, their livestock were not affected, they had food for themselves and their sheep, cattle and goats. Their crops were not destroyed. They had light, which means they had revelation, they heard the voice of the Lord, they learned to test prophecy, they understood spiritual things, because they drew near to God. WE MUST DO THE SAME!

Heb 10:19-25 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, NKJV

Ps 65:4 Blessed is the man You choose, and cause to approach You, that he may dwell in Your courts. We shall be satisfied with the goodness of Your house, of Your holy temple. NKJV

Ps 73:26-28. 26 My flesh and my heart fail; but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever. 27 For indeed, those who are far from You shall perish; You have destroyed all those who desert You for harlotry. 28 But it is good for me to draw near to

God; I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all Your works. NKJV

Jer 30:21-24. 21 Their nobles shall be from among them, And their governor shall come from their midst; then I will cause him to draw near, And he shall approach Me; For who is this who pledged his heart to approach Me?' says the LORD. 22'You shall be My people, And I will be your God.'" 23 Behold, the whirlwind of the LORD goes forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind; it will fall violently on the head of the wicked. 24 The fierce anger of the LORD will not return until He has done it, and until He has performed the intents of His heart. In the latter days you will consider it. NKJV

Heb 4:14-16. Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. NKJV

James 4:7-10 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. 9 Lament and mourn and weep! Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. 10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up. NKJV

Heb 7:17-19. 17 For He testifies: "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek." 18 For on the one hand there is an annulling of the former commandment because of its weakness and unprofitableness, 19 for the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, there is the bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God. NKJV

Heb 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. NKJV

THE GOSHANITES SAW GOD OVERCOME THEIR PROBLEMS AND WE WILL HAVE TO TRUST HIM TO DO THE SAME FOR US. THEY HAD MANY HARDSHIPS AND HAD TO WORK UNDER VERY DIFFICULT CIRCUMSTANCES, IT JUST MAYBE THAT WAY FOR US AS WELL.

THEY SPOILED EGYPT AS IT WAS PROPHECIED TO ABRAM IN GEN 15, SO THEY MUST HAVE HAD STRONG RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE EGYPTIANS.

Gen 15:14 And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward they shall come out with great possessions. NKJV

Ex 3:22 But every woman shall ask of her neighbor, namely, of her who dwells near her house, articles of silver, articles of gold, and clothing; and you shall put them on your sons and on your daughters. So you shall plunder the Egyptians." NKJV

Ex 11:2-3. 2 Speak now in the hearing of the people , and let every man ask from his neighbor and every woman from her neighbor, articles of silver and articles of gold." 3 And the LORD gave the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants and in the sight of the people. NKJV

Ex 12:35-36. 35 Now the children of Israel had done according to the word of Moses, and they had asked from the Egyptians articles of silver, articles of gold, and clothing. 36 And the LORD had given the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they granted them what they requested. Thus they plundered the Egyptians. NKJV

Luke 16:8-11. 8 So the master commended the unjust steward because he had dealt shrewdly. For the sons of this world are more shrewd in their generation than the sons of light. 9 "And I say to you, make friends for yourselves by unrighteous mammon, that when you fail, they may receive you into an everlasting home. 10 He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. NKJV

Ps 105:36-38. 36 He also destroyed all the firstborn in their land, the first of all their strength. 37 He also brought them out with silver and gold, And there was none feeble among His tribes. 38 Egypt was glad when they departed, for the fear of them had fallen upon them. NKJV

BE A VICTOR AND NOT A VICTIM IN EGYPT. HOW CAN WE BE SAFE IN GOSHAN?

UNDERSTAND BIBICAL FOUNDATIONS AND WHAT THEY ARE MADE OF. GO BACK TO THE BASICS ABOUT SALVATION, NEW BIRTH, TRUTH, ETC. DO NOT LET LAWLESSNESS (TORAH-LESS-NESS) AFFECT YOU.

UNDERSTAND THAT THERE ARE ENEMIES FIGHTING AGAINST US IN THE UNSEEN REALM. EG: THE OCCULT, OTHER RELIGIONS, FEAR, NATURAL DISASTERS, PRINICIPALITIES SUCH AS BABYLON, EGYPT, MOAB AND ASSYRIA, DECEPTION, FALSE PROPHETS, ETC.

Rev 19:6-8. **6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! 7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.** NKJV
