Vayigash "And came near"

Gen 44:18-47:27 / Ez 37:15-28 / Matt 23-25

Ps 116:13 I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.

Ge 44:11, 12 Then they speedily took down every man his sack to the ground, and opened every man his sack. And he searched, and began at the eldest, and left at the youngest: and the cup was found in Benjamin's sack.

Mt 27:38 Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left.

Le 9:5 And they brought that which Moses commanded before the tabernacle of the congregation: and all the congregation drew near קרב and stood before the LORD.

Ex 30:19,20 For Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet thereat: When they go into the tabernacle of the congregation, they shall wash with water, that they die not; or when they come near נגש to the altar to minister,

Jer 30:21b,22 ...and I will cause him to draw near, קרב and he shall approach נגש unto me: for who is this that engaged his heart to approach נגש unto me? saith the LORD. And ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

Jas 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you.

Ge 44:18 And Judah (came near)? him and said, O my lord, pray let your servant speak a word in my lord's ears, and do not let your anger burn against your servant, for you are even as Pharaoh.

Ge 44:32,33 For thy servant became surety for *the lad* unto my father, saying, If I bring him not unto thee, then I shall bear the blame to my father for ever. Now therefore, I pray thee, let thy servant abide instead of the lad a bondman to my lord; and let the lad go up with his brethren.

Ro 9:3 For I could wish that myself were accursed from Messiah for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:

Isa 53:4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

Joh 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

Ge 44:33 and let the lad go up with his brethren.

Ge 46:21 And the sons of Benjamin were Belah, and Becher, and Ashbel, Gera, and Naaman, Ehi, and Rosh, Muppim, and Huppim, and Ard.

Ge 45:1,2 Then Joseph could not control himself before all those who stood by him. And he cried, Cause every man to go out from me! And no man stood before him while Joseph made himself known to his brothers. And he wept aloud. And the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard.

Pr 20:12 The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the LORD hath made even both of them.

Le 16:17 And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

Re 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

Eze 20:35 And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will I plead with you face to face.

Ge 45:3 And Joseph said to his brothers, *I am Joseph*. Is **my** father still alive? And his brothers could not answer him, for they were troubled at his presence.

Ge 45:4,5 And Joseph said to his brothers, Please come near me. And they **came near**. And he said, **I am Joseph your brother**, whom you sold into Egypt. And now do not be grieved, nor angry with yourselves that you sold me here. For God sent me before you to preserve life.

Mt 26:15 And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.

Joh 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

De 17:15 you shall surely set a king over you, whom the LORD your God shall choose. You shall set a king over you from among your brothers. You may not set a stranger over you, who is not your brother.

Joh 12:13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Joh 19:19 And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Zep 3:15-17 The Lord has taken away those who were judging you, he has sent your haters far away: the King of Israel, even the Lord, is among you: you will have no more fear of evil. In that day it will be said to Jerusalem, Have no fear: O Zion, let not your hands be feeble. The Lord your God is among you, as a strong saviour: he will be glad over you with joy, he will make his love new again, he will make a song of joy over you as in the time of a holy feast.

De 17:18,9 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

Ge 45:6 For these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years...

Ge 45:7 And God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.

Ro 11:5 Even so then, also in this present time a remnant according to the election of grace has come into being.

Ro 11:15 For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead? (Jacob revived)

Isa 37:31,32 And the remnant who have escaped of the house of Judah Shall again take root downward, And bear fruit upward. For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, And those who escape from Mount Zion. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Joe 2:32 And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the LORD has said, Among the remnant whom the LORD calls.

Isa 10:20-22 And it shall come to pass in that day That the remnant of Israel, And such as have escaped of the house of Jacob, Will never again depend on him who defeated them, But will depend on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. The remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, To the Mighty God. For though your people, O Israel, be as the sand of the sea, A remnant of them will return; The destruction decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

Isa 4:2,3 In that day the Branch of the LORD shall be beautiful and glorious; And the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and appealing For those of Israel who have escaped. And it shall come to pass that he who is left in Zion and remains in Jerusalem will be called holy-everyone who is recorded among the living in Jerusalem.

Jer 50:20 In those days, and at that time, says the LORD, the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and it shall not be found; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found; for I will pardon those whom I leave as a remnant.

Eze 6:8,9 "Yet I will leave a remnant, so that you may have some who escape the sword among the nations, when you are scattered through the countries. "Then those of you who escape will remember Me among the nations where they are carried captive, because I was crushed by their adulterous heart which has departed from Me, and by their eyes which play the harlot after their idols; they will loathe themselves for the evils which they committed in all their abominations.

Ge 45:9,13 Hurry and go up to my father and say to him, So says your son Joseph, God has made me lord of all Egypt. Come down to me, do not wait. And you shall tell my father of all my glory in Egypt, and of all that you have seen. And you shall hurry and bring down my father here.

Re 22:20 He who testifies these things says, Yes, I am coming quickly, Amen.

Ge 45:17-24 And Pharaoh said to Joseph, Say to your brothers, Put your goods on your beasts and go back to the land of Canaan; And get your father and your families and come back to me: and I will give you all the good things of Egypt, and the fat of the land will be your food. And say to them, This you are to do: take carts from the land of Egypt for your little ones and for your wives, and get your father and come back. And take no thought for your goods, for the best of all the land of Egypt is yours. And the children of Israel did as he said; and Joseph gave them carts as had been ordered by Pharaoh, and food for their journey. To every one of them he gave three changes of clothing; but to Benjamin he gave three hundred bits of silver and five changes of clothing. And to his father he sent ten asses with good things from Egypt on their backs, and ten she-asses with grain and bread

and food for his father on the journey. And he sent his brothers on their way, and said to them, See that you have no argument on the road.

Re 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white.

Ge 45:26-28 And they told him, saying, **Joseph is still alive**, and he is governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he did not believe them. And they **told him** all the words of Joseph, which he had said to them. And when **he saw** the wagons which Joseph had sent to carry him, the spirit of Jacob their father **revived.** And **Israel** said, It is enough. Joseph my son is still alive. I will go and see him before I die.

Isa 53:1 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

Eze 37:1-6 The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones, And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, there were very many in the open valley; and, lo, they were very dry. And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord GOD, thou knowest. Again he said unto me, Prophecy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD. Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live: And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Eze 37:11 Then he said unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost: we are cut off for our parts.

Ge 42:36 And Jacob their father said unto them, Me have ye bereaved of my children: Joseph is not, and Simeon is not, and ye will take Benjamin away: all these things are against me.

Ge 43:1 And the famine was sore in the land.

Eze 37:16-21 Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel his companions: And join them one to another into one stick; and they shall become one in thine hand. And when the children of thy people shall speak unto thee, saying, Wilt thou not shew us what thou meanest by these? Say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel his fellows, and will put them with him, even with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they shall be one in mine hand. And the sticks whereon thou writest shall be in thine hand before their eyes. And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the

children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land:

Eze 37:25-28 And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David shall be their prince for ever. Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore. My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.

Isa 11:11a,12,13 It shall come to pass in that day That the Lord shall set His hand again the second time To recover the remnant of His people who are left, He will set up a banner for the nations, And will assemble the outcasts of Israel, And gather together the dispersed of Judah From the four corners of the earth. Also the envy of Ephraim shall depart, And the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off; Ephraim shall not envy Judah, And Judah shall not harass Ephraim.

Ge 50:20 But as for you, **you thought evil against me**, but God meant it for good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save a great many people alive.
