Ps 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Le 19:23 And when ye shall come into the land, and shall have planted all manner of trees for food, then ye shall count the fruit thereof as uncircumcised: three years shall it be as uncircumcised unto you: it shall not be eaten of. But in the fourth year all the fruit thereof shall be holy to praise the LORD withal. And in the fifth year shall ye eat of the fruit thereof, that it may yield unto you the increase thereof: I am the LORD your God.

Mt 21:19 And seeing a fig-tree by the wayside, he came to it, and saw nothing on it but leaves only; and he said to it, Let there be no fruit from you from this time forward for ever. And straight away the fig-tree became dry and dead.

Pr 27:18 Whoever keeps a fig-tree will have its fruit; and the servant waiting on his master will be honoured.

Zec 1:7-10 On the twenty-fourth day of the eleventh month, the month Shebat, in the second year of Darius, the word of the Lord came to Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying, I saw in the night a man on a red horse, between the mountains in the valley, and at his back were horses, red, black, white, and of mixed colours. Then I said, O my lord, what are these? And the angel who was talking to me said to me, I will make clear to you what they are. And the man who was between the mountains, answering me, said, These are those whom the Lord has sent to go up and down through the earth.

Zec 1:17-21 And again let your voice be loud and say, This is what the Lord of armies has said: My towns will again be overflowing with good things, and again the Lord will give comfort to Zion and take Jerusalem for himself. And lifting up my eyes I saw four horns. And I said to the angel who was talking to me, What are these? And he said to me, These are the horns which have sent Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem in flight. And the Lord gave me a vision of four metal-workers. Then I said, What have these come to do? And he said, These are the horns which sent Judah in flight, and kept him from lifting up his head: but these men have come to send fear on them and to put down the nations who are lifting up their horns against the land of Judah to send it in flight.

Ex 6:2-5 And God spoke to Moses, and said to him, I am Jehovah יהוה. And I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob as God Almighty. But I was not known to them by the name JEHOVAH יהוה. And I also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers. And I have also heard the groaning of the sons of Israel, those whom the Egyptians are keeping in bondage. And I have remembered My covenant.

Gen 12:7,8 And the LORD יהוה appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land: and there builded he an altar unto the LORD יהוה, *who appeared* unto him. And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, having Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto the LORD יהוה, and called upon the name of the LORD יהוה.

Gen 4:26 And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the LORD יהוה.

#2490. חָלַל chalal, to wound, to dissolve; figuratively, to profane

Gen 28:13 And, behold, the LORD יהוה stood above it, and said, I am the LORD יהוה God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

Ex 3:6-8 Moreover he said, I am the God אלהים of thy father, the God אלהים of Abraham, the God אלהים of Isaac, and the God אלהים of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God אלהים. And the LORD יהוה said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians,

Ex 6:6-8 Therefore say to the sons of Israel, I am Jehovah, יהוה and *I will* bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and *I will* rescue you out of their bondage. And *I will* redeem you with a stretched-out arm, and with great judgments. And *I will* take you to Me for a people, and *I will* be to you a God. And you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. And *I will* bring you in to the land concerning which I lifted up My hand to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. And *I will* give it to you for a heritage. I am the LORD!

Psalm 116:13 I will take the cup of salvations, and call upon the name of the LORD.

Luke 22:17,19,20 And he took the cup(2nd), and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves: And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. Likewise also the cup(3rd) after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

1. I will bring you out - the first cup called cup of sanctification or "separation"
2. I will rid you of their bondage - the second cup called deliverance or "judgment"
3. I will redeem you - the third cup which is called "redemption" or "blessing"
4. I will take you - the fourth cup, called cup of acceptance or "praise"
5. I will be to you an Elohim
6. I will bring you into the land
7. I will give it (the land) to you for a heritage

Ro 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Messiah died for us.

Ex 7:16 And you shall say unto him, The LORD God of the Hebrews hath sent me unto thee, saying, Let my people go, that they may serve me in the wilderness:

Jer 32:17 Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm,

Psalm 49:7,8 None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth forever:)

The 4th cup is the Cup of Acceptance: "I will take you to me for a people"

Ez 29:2-7a Son of man, set your face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him and against all Egypt. Speak and say, So says the Lord Jehovah: Behold, I am against you, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the great dragon. רַבֵּי who lies in the midst of his rivers, who has said, My river is mine, and I have made it. But I will put hooks in your jaws, and I will cause the fish of your rivers to stick to your scales, and I will bring you up out of the midst of your rivers, and all the fish of your rivers shall stick to your scales. And I will leave you to the wilderness, you and all the fish of your rivers. You shall fall on the open fields; you shall not be removed nor gathered. I have given you for food to the beasts of the field and to the birds of the heavens. And all the people of Egypt shall know that I am the LORD, because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel. When they took you by your hand, you broke and tore off all their shoulder. (MKJV)

תַּנִּינַיַּן tanniyn: dragon, sea-monster

"Behold, I am against you, O Pharaoh king of Egypt, O great monster תַּנִּינַיַּן who lies in the midst of his rivers (NKJV)

"Pharaoh is likened to a word תַּנִּינַיַּן tanniyn; which represented both the crocodile, which the Nile was infested with, and also the chaos monster of mythology."

Is 27:1 In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, even leviathan that crooked serpent נַחַשׁ <nachash>; and he shall slay the dragon תַּנִּינַיַּן <tanniyn> that is in the sea.

Re 20:1,2 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years;

Ex 4:2,3 And the LORD said unto him, What is that in your hand? And he said, A rod. And he said, Cast it on the ground. And he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent נַחַשׁ <nachash>;

Ex 7:9,10 "When Pharaoh speaks to you, saying, 'Show a miracle for yourselves,' then you shall say to Aaron, 'Take your rod and cast it before Pharaoh, and let it become a serpent.'" So Moses and Aaron went in to Pharaoh, and they did so, just as the LORD commanded. And Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh and before his servants, and it became a serpent. תַּנִּינַיַּן <tanniyn>.

Ex 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Ex 8:32 And Pharaoh hardened his heart at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

Ex 9:34 And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his heart,

#3513. כָּבֵד kabed a primitive root; to be heavy, i.e. in a bad sense (burdensome, severe, dull) to make weighty

#2388. חָזַק chazaq, a primitive root; to fasten upon; to strengthen, help along,

Ex 9:12 And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had spoken unto Moses.

Ex 10:20 But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go.

Ex 6:12 "Moses spoke before God, saying, 'Behold, the children of Israel haven't listened to me. How then shall Pharaoh listen to me, who am of uncircumcised lips?'"

Jer 6:10 To whom shall I speak, and give warning, that they may hear? behold, their ear is uncircumcised, and they cannot hearken: behold, the word of the LORD is unto them a reproach; they have no delight in it.

Le 26:41 And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled,

Ex 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

Ex 7:20 And Moses and Aaron did so, as the LORD commanded; and he lifted up the rod, and smote the waters that were in the river, in the sight of Pharaoh, and in the sight of his servants; and all the waters that were in the river were turned to blood.

Ex 8:6,7 And Aaron stretched out his hand over the waters of Egypt, and the frogs came up and covered the land of Egypt. And the priests did so with their secret arts, and brought up frogs upon the land of Egypt.

Ex 8:19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Lu 11:20-22 But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you. When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace: But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.

Mt 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Ex 31:18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

Ex 9:16 "But indeed for this purpose I have raised you up, that I may show My power in you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth.

Joh 17:6 I have revealed Your name to the men whom You gave to Me out of the world.

Joh 17:25,26 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Joh 1:14-18 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me. And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace. For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

Josh 2:10,11 "For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red Sea for you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites who were on the other side of the Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom you utterly destroyed. "And as soon as we heard these things, our hearts melted; neither did there remain any more courage in anyone because of you, for the LORD your God, He is God in heaven above and on earth beneath.

1Sam 4:7,8 So the Philistines were afraid, for they said, "God has come into the camp!" And they said, "Woe to us! For such a thing has never happened before. "Woe to us! Who will deliver us from the hand of these mighty gods? These are the gods who struck the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness.

Eze 28:25,26 Thus saith the Lord GOD; When I shall have gathered the house of Israel from the people among whom they are scattered, and shall be sanctified in them in the sight of the heathen, then shall they dwell in their land that I have given to my servant Jacob. And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I am the LORD their God.

Ex 3:20 And I will stretch out my hand, and smite Egypt with all my wonders which I will do in the midst thereof: and after that he will let you go.

Ex 7:5 And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

Ex 8:5 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Stretch forth your hand with your rod over the streams, over the rivers, and over the ponds, and cause frogs to come up upon the land of Egypt.

Ex 9:22 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch forth your hand toward heaven, that there may be hail in all the land of Egypt

Mr 3:4-6 And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace. And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other. And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

In Psalm 77:15 "You have redeemed your people with your arm, the sons of Jacob and Joseph.
