Exodus 35:1 And Moses assembled all the congregation of the children of Israel, and said to them, These are the words which the LORD has commanded, that you should do them.

Acts 7:37,38 This is that Moses, who said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall God raise up unto you from among your brethren, like unto me. This is he that was in the **church in the wilderness** with the angel that spake to him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers: who received living oracles to give unto us:

Acts 19:33,34 Some of the crowd prompted Alexander, whom the Jews had put forward. And Alexander, motioning with his hand, wanted to make a defense to the crowd. But when they recognized that he was a Jew, for about two hours they all cried out with one voice, "Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!"

Acts 19:35,41 And when the town clerk had quieted the crowd, he said, "Men of Ephesus, who is there who does not know that the city of the Ephesians is temple keeper of the great Artemis, and of the sacred stone that fell from the sky?"

And when he had said these things, he **dismissed the assembly**.

Exodus 35:2a ‘Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be a holy day for you, a Sabbath of solemn rest to the LORD:

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah is the goal of the ‘Torah unto righteousness’ to everyone who believes.

Leviticus 23:34-36 “Speak to the children of Israel, and say, ‘On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of booths for seven days to the LORD. On the first day shall be a holy convocation: you shall do no regular work. Seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. On the eighth day shall be a holy convocation to you; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a solemn assembly: you shall do no regular work.

Exodus 35:4,5 Moses said to all the congregation of the people of Israel, “This is the thing that the Lord has commanded. Take from among you a contribution to the Lord. Whoever is of a generous heart, let him bring the Lord's contribution: gold, silver, and bronze;

Exodus 35:20-22 And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD's offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: and every man that offered, offered an offering of gold to the LORD.

Exodus 35:25 And all the women that were wise hearted did spin with their hands,

Exodus 35:29 All the men and women, the people of Israel, whose heart moved them to bring anything for the work that the Lord had commanded by Moses to be done brought it as a freewill offering to the Lord.

Exodus 35:30,31 And Moses said to the children of Israel, See, the LORD has called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah; And he has filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship;

Exodus 35:34,35a And he has put in his heart that he may teach, both he, and **Aholiab**, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. Them has he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work,

Exodus 36:1,2 Then worked Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the LORD put wisdom and

understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded. And Moses called Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whose heart the LORD had put wisdom, even every one whose heart stirred him up to come to the work to do it:

Genesis 1:27 God created man in his own image. In God's image **צֶלֶם** he created him; male and female he created them.

Psalms 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

Colossians 2:16,17 Let no one therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a feast day or a new moon or a Sabbath day, which are a shadow of the things to come; but the body is Messiah's.

Exodus 36:5-8 And they spoke to Moses, saying, The people bring much more than enough for the service of the work, which the LORD commanded to make. And Moses gave commandment, and they caused it to be proclaimed throughout the camp, saying, Let neither man nor woman make any more work for the offering of the sanctuary. So the people were restrained from bringing. For the stuff they had was sufficient for all the work to make it, and too much. And every wise hearted man among them that worked the work of the tabernacle made ten curtains of fine twined linen,

Exodus 38:25,26 The silver of those who were numbered of the congregation was one hundred talents, and one thousand seven hundred seventy-five shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary: a beka **בַּקָּע** a head **גִּלְגֻלֵּת**, that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that passed over to them that were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

Genesis 24:2-4 And Abraham said unto his oldest servant of his house, that ruled over all that he had, Put, I pray you, your hand under my thigh: And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that you shalt not take a wife to my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell: But you shalt go to my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife to my son Isaac.

Genesis 24:22 And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a golden earring of half a shekel **בַּקָּע** weight, and two bracelets for her hands of ten shekels weight of gold;

Mark 15:22 And they bring him to the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.

Decoding the Antichrist

Theology in the early Church / Replacement theology

Acts 21:37 Then as Paul was about to be led into the barracks, he said to the commander, “May I speak to you?” He replied, “Can you speak **Greek**?”

Acts 21:39,40 But Paul said, “I am a Jew from Tarsus, in Cilicia, a citizen of no mean city; and I implore you, permit me to speak to the people.” So when he had given him permission, Paul stood on the stairs and motioned with his hand to the people. And when there was a great silence, he spoke to them in the **Hebrew** language,

Acts 22:25,26 And as they bound him with thongs, Paul said to the centurion who stood by, “Is it lawful for you to scourge a man who is **a Roman**, and uncondemned?”

When the centurion heard that, he went and told the commander, saying, “Take care what you do, for this man is a Roman.”

Acts 17:16 Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him when he saw that the city was given over to idols.

Acts 17:18 And certain of the Epicurean and of the Stoic philosophers, were meeting together to see him, and some were saying, ‘What would this seed picker wish to say?’

Acts 17:28 “For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.”

Epimenides believed Zeus was immortal. Epimenides’ poem addresses Zeus as follows:

*They fashioned a tomb for you, holy and high one,
Cretans, always liars, evil beasts, idle bellies.
But you are not dead: you live and abide forever,
For in you we live and move and have our being.*

Titus 1:12 “One of themselves, **even a prophet of their own**, said, the Cretians are always liars, evil beasts, slow bellies.”

Aratus from Cilicia (310–240 BC). Here’s a passage from his best-known poem, Phenomena (astronomy):

NOTES:

*Let us begin with Zeus, whom we mortals never leave unspoken.
For every street, every marketplace is full of Zeus.
Even the sea and the harbor are full of this deity.
Everywhere everyone is indebted to Zeus,
For we are indeed his offspring.*

1 Corinthians 15:33 “Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.”

1 Corinthians 1:17–21 For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—not with wisdom and eloquence, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power. For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written: “I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate.” Where is the wise person? Where is the teacher of the law? Where is the philosopher of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe.

Matthew 11:25,26 But Yeshua called them to himself, and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. It shall not be so among you, but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant.

3John 1:9-12 I have written something to the church, but Diotrephes, who likes to put himself first, does not acknowledge our authority. So if I come, I will bring up what he is doing, talking wicked nonsense against us. And not content with that, he refuses to welcome the brothers, and also stops those who want to and puts them out of the church.

Justin Martyr (c. AD 160), speaking to a Jew said, “*The Scriptures are not yours, but ours.*”

Irenaeus, Bishop of Lyons (c. AD 177), declared, “*Jews are disinherited from the grace of God.*”

Tertullian (AD 160–230) in his treatise “*Against the Jews*” announced that God had rejected the Jews in favor of the Christians.

Eusebius wrote that the promises of the Hebrew Scriptures were for Christians and not the Jews, and the curses were for the Jews. He argued that the Church was the continuation of the Old Testament and thus superseded Judaism. The young Church declared itself to be the true Israel, or “*Israel according to the Spirit,*” heir to the divine promises.

NOTES:

St. Jerome (AD 347-407) describes the Jews as "... serpents, wearing the image of Judas, their psalms and prayers are the braying of donkeys."

John Chrysostom (Golden Tongued), the great orator, wrote a series of eight sermons against the Jews. To quote him: "the synagogue is not only a brothel and a theater; it is also a den of robbers and a lodging for wild beasts. No Jew adores God... Jews are inveterate murderers, possessed by the devil, their debauchery and drunkenness gives them the manners of the pig.

Augustine confronted this problem in his "Sermon Against the Jews." He maintained that even though the Jews deserved the most severe punishment for having "killed our Jesus" but that they have been kept alive by Divine Providence to serve, together with their Scriptures, as witnesses to the truth of Christianity.

Martin Luther (1483–1546)

First to set fire to their synagogues or schools and to bury and cover with dirt whatever will not burn,

Second, I advise that their houses also be razed and destroyed

I advise that safe conduct on the highways be abolished completely for the Jews.

I advise that...all cash and treasure of silver and gold be taken from them
