

Leviticus 27:14 And when a man shall <u>sanctify his</u> <u>house to be holy</u> unto the Lord

Leviticus 27:28 Notwithstanding no devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the Lord of all that he hath, both of <u>man and beast</u>, and of <u>the field of his possession</u>, shall be sold or redeemed: <u>every devoted thing is most holy</u> unto the Lord.

Leviticus 27:21 But <u>the field</u>, when it goeth out in the jubilee, <u>shall be holy</u> unto the Lord, as a field devoted; the possession thereof shall be the priest's.

Acts 5:1,2 But a certain man named Hananiah, with Shappirah, his wife, sold a possession, and kept back part of the price, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the emissaries' feet.

Acts 5:4,5 While you kept it, didn't it remain your own? After it was sold, wasn't it in your power? How is it that you have conceived this thing in your heart? You haven't lied to men, but to God." Hananiah, hearing these words, fell down and died. Great fear came on all who heard these things.

Leviticus 19:1,2 And the Lord spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: קרשים for I the Lord your God am holy.

1 Peter 1:15,16 But as <u>he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy</u> in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, <u>Be ye holy</u>; for I am holy.

Ephesians 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him <u>before the</u> <u>foundation of the world</u>, <u>that we should be holy</u> and without blame before him in love:

Ephesians 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious assembly, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it <u>should be holy</u> and without blemish.

Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, <u>and holiness</u>, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Revelations 22:11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

Isaiah 65:1-5 "I am inquired of by those who didn't ask; I am found by those who didn't seek me: I said, See me, see me, to a nation that was not called by my name. I have spread out my hands all the day to a rebellious people, who walk in a way that is not good, after their own thoughts; a people who provoke me to my face continually, sacrificing in gardens, and burning incense on bricks; who sit among the graves, and lodge in the secret places; who eat pig's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels; who say, Stand by yourself, don't come near to me, for I am holier than you. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burns all the day.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus says the high and lofty One who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also who is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite.



Psalm 99:3 Let them praise thy great and terrible name; for it is holy.

Isaiah 40:25 To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith <u>the Holy One</u>

Luke 4:33,34 And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice, Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God

Leviticus 19:3 "Each one of you shall respect his mother and his father. You shall keep my Sabbaths. I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 19:9,10 "When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field, neither shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest. You shall not glean your vineyard, neither shall you gather the fallen grapes of your vineyard; <u>you shall leave them for the poor and for the foreigner</u>. I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 19:11,12 "You shall not steal. "You shall not lie. "You shall not deceive one another. "You shall not swear by my name falsely, and profane the name of your God. I am the LORD.

Leviticus 19:13 "You shall not oppress your neighbor, nor rob him. "The wages of a hired servant shall not remain with you all night until the morning.

Leviticus 19:15 "You shall do no injustice in judgment: you shall not be partial to the poor, nor show favoritism to the great; but you shall judge your neighbor in righteousness.

Leviticus 19:16-18 "You shall not go up and down <u>as a slanderer</u> among your people. "You shall not endanger the life of your neighbor. I am the LORD. "You shall not hate your brother in your heart. You shall surely rebuke your neighbor, and not bear sin because of him. "You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people; but you shall **love your neighbor** as yourself. I am the LORD.

Luke 10:27-29 He answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." He said to him, "You have answered correctly. Do this, and you will live." But he, desiring to justify himself, asked Yeshua, "Who is my neighbor?"

Leviticus 19:33,34 'And if a stranger dwells with you in your land, you shall not mistreat him. <u>'The stranger</u> who dwells among you shall be to you as one born among you, <u>and you shall love him as yourself</u>; for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 20:7 Sanctify yourselves therefore, and <u>be ye holy: for I am the Lord your God.</u> And ye shall <u>keep my statutes, and do them:</u> I am the Lord which <u>sanctify you.</u>

Leviticus 19:30 "You shall keep my Sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary; I am the LORD.

Leviticus 20:23-26 You shall not walk in the customs of the nation, which I am casting out before you: for they did all these things, and therefore I abhorred them. But I have said to you, "You shall inherit their land, and I will give it to you to possess it, a land flowing with milk and honey." I am the LORD your God, who has separated you from the peoples. "'You shall therefore make a distinction between the clean







animal and the unclean, and between the unclean fowl and the clean: and you shall not make yourselves abominable by animal, or by bird, or by anything with which the ground teems, which I have separated from you as unclean for you. **You shall be holy to me: for I, the LORD, am holy,** and have set you apart from the peoples, that you should be mine.

Amos 9:8-10 Behold, the eyes of the Lord GOD are on the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from off the surface of the earth; except that I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob," says the LORD. "For, behold, I will command, and I will sift the house of Israel among all the nations, as grain is sifted in a sieve, yet not the least kernel will fall on the earth. **All the sinners of my people will die by the sword, who say, 'Evil won't overtake nor meet us.'**

Amos 9:11,12 In that day I will raise up the tent of David who is fallen, and close up its breaches, and I will raise up its ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old; that they may possess the remnant of Edom, and all the nations who are called by my name," says the LORD who does this.

Acts 15:14-18 Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name. And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written, After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: That **the residue of men** might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things. Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.

Mark 12:28-31 And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all? And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.
