HOW GREAT IS OUR GOD

Ps 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.

Job 22:12 Is not God in the height of heaven? and behold the height of the stars, how high they are!

Ps 147:4 He telleth the number of the stars; he calleth them all by their names.

Job 38:31 Can thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion?

Am 5:8 Seek him that maketh the seven stars and Orion, and turneth the shadow of death into the morning, and maketh the day dark with night: that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD is his name:

Job 9:6-9 Which shaketh the earth out of her place, and the pillars thereof tremble. Which commandeth the sun, and it riseth not; and sealeth up the stars. Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea. Which maketh **Arcturus, Orion, and Pleiades**, and the chambers of the south.



Isa 40:12-15 Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with the span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance? Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or being his counsellor hath taught him? With whom took he counsel, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and shewed to him the way of understanding? Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing.

Ps 33:6 By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

The First letter in Hebrew is the Aleph our A. In today's Hebrew it looks like this א, but

in David's day it looked like this: א and in Moses day like this: א

The very letter aleph means several things including ox or that which goes first and that which is strong like an ox.

The second letter in Hebrew is the Bet our b. In today's Hebrew it looks like this ב, but in David's day it looked like this:  and in Moses day like this: 

The very letter Bet in Hebrew means house so David drew a tent on a landscape and Moses drew a 3 room house.

The first two letters are aleph, bet where we get our term Alphabet!
Now let's look at more of the picture language from your charts!

If you notice their letters aleph and bet became our letters  and 


Abba means daddy and Ab means father. The picture language tells us father is the strength of the house!

Ge 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:

At Passover God gave a sign:

Ex 12:13 ` And the blood hath become a sign for you on the houses where ye are, and I have seen the blood, and have passed over you, and a plague is not on you for destruction in My smiting in the land of Egypt.

The Hebrew word for sign is אֵימָנוּת pronounced Oth. In Ancient Hebrew Moses wrote it like

this:  or the Leader nailed to the cross/covenant!!!
