- How should we act?

Protocol - a system of rules that explain the correct conduct and procedures to be followed in formal situations.

Who follows protocol? Most of us in one way or another in Business, family, church, public activities.

Why follow protocol?

- When you represent a company, dignitary, or group of people
- Because you represent them and you don't want to give the wrong impression of their beliefs, thoughts or feelings.
- To keep from embarrassing yourself or others.

Who does a daughter of the King represent?

- The King – They represent him at formal functions with the people or dignitaries or government events.
- Royals and famous people are never alone or truly free from observation.
- We also are on display for all to see. We represent our Father everywhere we go.
 - To the people we work with
 - To the people we meet in the market or organizations
 - To our family

An example of failing to represent God well. Moses

Numbers 20 - 13 "Take the rod; and you and your brother Aaron assemble the congregation and speak to the rock before their eyes, that it may yield its water. You shall thus bring forth water for them out of the rock and let the congregation and their beasts drink."

9 So Moses took the rod from before the Lord, just as He had commanded him; 10 and Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly before the rock. And he said to them, "Listen now, you rebels; shall we bring forth water for you out of this rock?" 11 Then Moses lifted up his hand and struck the rock twice with his rod; and water came forth

abundantly, and the congregation and their beasts drank. 12 But the Lord said to Moses and Aaron, “Because you have not believed Me, to treat Me as holy in the sight of the sons of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land which I have given them.” 13 Those were the waters of Meribah, because the sons of Israel contended with the Lord, and He proved Himself holy among them.

A good example

Hebrews 1 (NASB) God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. ³ And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴ having become as much better than the angels, as He has inherited a more excellent name than they.

Our Value as Daughters of the King

1 John 3:1-3 (NLT) See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are! But the people who belong to this world don't recognize that we are God's children because they don't know him. ² Dear friends, we are already God's children, but he has not yet shown us what we will be like when Christ appears. But we do know that we will be like him, for we will see him as he really is. ³ And all who have this eager expectation will keep themselves pure, just as he is pure.

John 1:12-13 (NLT) ¹² But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of God. ¹³ They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God.

Therefore!!!

“We're going to identify ourselves in Christ, not in relationship, not with a man, not with children. Not with anything else but Christ, because when that happens, we can identify who we are in Christ, we become closer to the image He created. We can fulfill the destiny He has for us.” Diana Hagee in “The Kings Daughters”

Ephesians 4:1-2 (NASB) Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, ² with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, ³ being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

- If we are not secure in who we are our insecurities show up in feelings of inferiority, inadequacy, guilt, rejection, and unworthiness.
- These feelings lead to actions of contempt, jealousy, gossip, and a critical spirit

1 Corinthians 13:1-4 (NASB) If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ² If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. ³ And if I give all my possessions to feed the poor, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.

4 Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, ⁵ does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*, ⁶ does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; ⁷ bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

- Going back to the quote I showed you earlier. (How do we love God our Father?)
- Everything depends on that. All we become, all we are, all we do is here with Him.

How then shall we live?

Colossians 3:12-17 (NLT) ¹² Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. ¹³ Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. ¹⁴ Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. ¹⁵ And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful.

¹⁶ Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. ¹⁷ And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father.

Jeremiah 15:19-21 New American Standard Bible (NASB)

¹⁹ Therefore, thus says the LORD,
"If you return, then I will restore you—
Before Me you will stand;
And if you extract the precious from the worthless,
You will become My spokesman.
They for their part may turn to you,
But as for you, you must not turn to them.
²⁰ "Then I will make you to this people
A fortified wall of bronze;
And though they fight against you,
They will not prevail over you;
For I am with you to save you
And deliver you," declares the LORD.
²¹ "So I will deliver you from the hand of the wicked,
And I will redeem you from the grasp of the violent."

Jeremiah 15:19-21 New Living Translation (NLT)

¹⁹ This is how the LORD responds: "If you return to me, I will restore you so you can continue to serve me.

If you speak good words rather than worthless ones,
you will be my spokesman.

You must influence them;
do not let them influence you!

²⁰ They will fight against you like an attacking army,
but I will make you as secure as a fortified wall of bronze.

They will not conquer you,
for I am with you to protect and rescue you.
I, the LORD, have spoken!

²¹ Yes, I will certainly keep you safe from these wicked men.
I will rescue you from their cruel hands."

Result of our Salvation is Authority – John 1:12-13

¹² But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name, ¹³ who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

Result of Baptism of the Holy Spirit is power – 1 Corinthians 4:20 (NLT) ²⁰ For the Kingdom of God is not just a lot of talk; it is living by God's power. Power to be a witness

- 1 Power to pray according to God's will Ephesians 6:18; 1 Thessalonians 5:17
The fire on the altar should not go out
- 2 Power to understand God's Word – John 14:26
- 3 Power to experience the Pouring out of God's love – Romans 5:5; 1 Peter 1:22-23
- 4 Power to give and to serve others
