TRUST - FAITH - BELIEVE

TRUST:

Chasah OT #2620 חָסָה – to flee for protection; have hope, make refuge,

- ❖ **Psalm 91:4 (NASB)** under His wings you may seek refuge;

Batach OT #982 בָּטַח – to trust, be confident or sure, hope

- ❖ **Isaiah 12:2 (KJV)** Behold, God (is) my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid:

FAITH:

Emunah OT #530 אֱמוּנָה – firmness; security, fidelity; faith, stability, steady, truth

- ❖ **Deuteronomy 32:4 (CJB)** The Rock! His work is perfect, for all his ways are just. A trustworthy God who does no wrong, he is righteous and straight.

- ❖ **Lamentations 3:23 (TLV)** Great is your faithfulness

Pistis NT #4102 πίστις – assurance, belief, faith, fidelity, trust

- ❖ **Luke 17:5 (KJV)** And the apostles said unto the Lord, “Increase our faith”

BELIEVE:

Aman OT#539 אָמַן - to confirm, support

- ❖ **Genesis 15:6 (KJV)** And he believed in the LORD, and he counted it to him for righteousness

Example #1 - Miryam

Luke 1:26-38 (HNV): Now in the sixth month, the angel Gavri'el was sent from God to a city of the Galil, named Natzeret, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man whose name was Yosef, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Miryam. Having come in to her, the angel said, "Rejoice, you highly favored one! The Lord is with you. Blessed are you among women!" But when she saw him, she was greatly troubled at the saying, and considered what kind of salutation this might be. The angel said to her, "Don't be afraid, Miryam, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb, and bring forth a son, and will call his name 'Yeshua.' He will be great, and will be called the Son of Ha`Elyon. The Lord God will give to him the throne of his father, David, and he will reign over the house of Ya`akov forever. There will be no end of his kingdom." Miryam said to the angel, "How will this be, seeing I am a virgin?" The angel answered her, "The Ruach HaKodesh will come on you, and the power of Ha`Elyon will overshadow you. Therefore also the holy one who is born from you will be called the Son of God. Behold, Elisheva, your relative, also has conceived a son in her old age; and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. For no word from God will be void of power." Miryam said, "Behold, the handmaid of the Lord; be it to me according to your word." The angel departed from her.

Doule NT #1399 δοῦλος –to tie, bind; a female slave, handmaid

- **KEY TO RISING ABOVE IS TO BE ONE WHO WORSHIPS GOD AND SUBMITS TO HIM ALONE AND HAS FAITH TO BELIEVE THE TRUTH OF HIS WRITTEN WORD.**

Example #2 - Woman with the issue of blood

Mark 5:25-34 (TLV) And there was a woman with a blood flow for twelve years, who had suffered much under many doctors. She had spent all that she had without benefit; instead, she grew worse. When she heard about *Yeshua*, she came through the crowd from behind and touched His garment. For she kept saying, "If I touch even His clothes, I shall be healed." Right away the blood flow stopped, and she felt in her body that she was healed from her disease. At once *Yeshua*, knowing in Himself that power had gone out from Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?" His disciples responded, "You see the crowd pressing upon You and you say, 'Who touched Me?'" But He kept looking around to see who had done this. But the woman, scared and shaking, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in *shalom* and be healed from your disease."

Malachi 4:2 (OJB 3:20) But unto you that fear My name shall the Shemesh Tzedakah (sun of righteousness) arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth,

The word "wings" used here is the same as the word "corner" seen in Numbers 15:38 which refers to the tassles and tzitzit:

Kanaph OT #3671 כַּנָּף – wings, corner, borders

Himation NT #2440 ἱμάτιον – a garment, i.e. cloak or mantle

- **KEY TO RISING ABOVE IS TO BE ONE WHO DOES NOT GIVE UP HOPE IN THE MIDST OF DISCOURAGING CIRCUMSTANCES AND LIVES BY EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS FROM THE MOUTH OF GOD.**

Remember the words of the Archangel Gavri'el? For no word from God will be void of power.

Hebrews 10:32-39 (TLV) But remember the former days when, after you were enlightened, you endured a great struggle with sufferings. Sometimes you were publicly exposed to abuses and afflictions, and other times you became partners with those who were treated this way. For you suffered along with the prisoners and joyfully accepted the plundering of your possessions, knowing that you have for yourselves a better and lasting possession. Therefore, do not lose your boldness, which has great reward. For you need perseverance so that, after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise. For yet

“in a very little while,
the Coming One will come,
and He will not delay
But My righteous one shall live by *emunah*,”

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith and not by sight.
