WORSHIP ACCORDING TO DAVID'S TABERNACLE

**2 Samuel 6: 5-8** And David and all the house of Israel played before the Lord on all manner of instruments. And when they came to Nachon's threshing floor, Uzzah put forth his hand to the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook it. And the anger of the Lord was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for his error; and there he died by the ark of God.

**2 Sam 6:10** So David would not remove the ark of the Lord unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite. And the ark of the Lord continued in the house of Obededom the Gittite three months: and the Lord blessed Obededom, and all his household.

**2 Samuel 6:14-17** And David danced before the Lord with all his might; and David was girded with a linen ephod. So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the Lord with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet. And they brought in the ark of the Lord, and set it in his place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the Lord.

**1 Chronicles 23:1,2** So when David was old and full of days, he made Solomon his son king over Israel. And he gathered together all the princes of Israel, with the priests and the Levites.

**1 Chronicles 23:4,5** Of which, twenty and four thousand were to set forward the work of the house of the Lord; and six thousand were officers and judges: Moreover four thousand were porters; and **four thousand praised the Lord with the instruments which I made, said David, to praise therewith.**

***David was a worshipper:***

**Psalm 57:8,9** Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I myself will awake early. I will praise thee, O Lord, among the people: I will sing unto thee among the nations.

**Psalm 119:62** At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments.

**Amos 9:11** In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:

**Isaiah 16:5** And in mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, **judging, and seeking judgment**, and hastening righteousness. Give thanks unto the Lord, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the Lord.

**1 Chronicles 28:11-13** Then David gave his son Solomon the plans for the vestibule, its houses, its treasuries, its upper chambers, its inner chambers, and the place of the mercy seat; and the plans for all that he had by the Spirit, for the priests and the Levites, for all the work of the service of the house of the Lord, and for all the articles of service in the house of the Lord.

**1Chronicles 28:19** “All this,” said David, “the Lord made me understand in writing, by His hand upon me, all the works of these plans.”

**Exodus 25:17-22** You shall make a mercy seat of pure gold. Two cubits and a half shall be its length, and a cubit and a half its breadth. **And you shall make two cherubim of gold; of hammered work shall you make them, on the two ends of the mercy seat. Make one cherub on the one end, and one cherub on the other end.** Of one piece with the mercy seat shall you make the cherubim on its two ends. The cherubim shall spread out their wings above, overshadowing the mercy seat with their wings, their faces one to another; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubim be. **And you shall put the mercy seat on the top of the ark, and in the ark you shall put the testimony that I shall give you. There I will meet with you,** and from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim that are on the ark of the testimony, I will speak with you about all that I will give you in commandment for the people of Israel.

**Some of the different forms of worship:**

***Raising hands and bowing for worship is mentioned***

**Nehemiah 8:6** And Ezra blessed the Lord, the great God. Then all the people answered, “**Amen, Amen!**” while lifting up their hands. **And they bowed their heads and worshiped the Lord with their faces to the ground.**

**Ps 95:6** O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the Lord our maker.

**Ps 141:2** Let my prayer be set before You as incense, The lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

**1Timothy 2:8** I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, **lifting up holy hands,**

***Clapping, shouting, making a joyful noise:***

**Ps 47:1** Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples! **Shout to God** with the voice of triumph!

**Ps 98:4** **Make a joyful noise** unto the Lord, all the earth: **make a loud noise,** and rejoice, and sing praise.

***Dancing and using musical instruments:***

**Ps 149:3** Let them **praise his name in the dance:** let them sing praises unto him with the **timbrel and harp.**

**Ps 150:3,4 Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp. Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.**

**Hebrews 4:14-16 Come boldly to the throne of Grace,**

***What happened between the porch and the altar?***

**2<sup>nd</sup> Kings 23:**

**Joel 2:12-13 Therefore also now, saith the Lord, turn ye even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning: And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the Lord your God**

**Joel 2:17 Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, Weep between the porch and the altar; Let them say, "Spare Your people, O Lord, and do not give Your heritage to reproach, That the nations should rule over them.**

**Ezekiel 8:14-16 So He brought me (Ezekiel) to the door of the north gate of the Lord's house; and to my dismay, women were sitting there weeping for Tammuz. Then He said to me, "Have you seen this, O son of man? Turn again, you will see greater abominations than these." So He brought me into the inner court of the Lord's house; and there, **at the door of the temple of the Lord, between the porch and the altar, were about twenty-five men with their backs toward the temple of the Lord and their faces toward the east, and they were worshiping the sun toward the east.****

*Order of Worship ...*

*Opening of Worship Service or Procession.*

**Where : In the Women's Court**

*Songs of declaration, to each other and to God, high praise,  
encouraging one another, songs leading to repentance*

**Songs of repentance**

**Where: Israelite Court, Brazen Altar and Bronze laver**

also between Porch and Altar **Songs of intercession as well as repentance....**

**One on one fellowship with Hashem**

**WHERE: HOLY PLACE AND HOLY OF HOLIES**

Intimate prayer and worship, time to listen quietly
