Revelation 19:7 Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready.

Hebrew 12:2 Looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Matthew 7:22-25 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name? And then I will declare to them, I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.....

Revelation 22:14 Blessed are those who do his commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city.

John 15:10 As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Remain in my love. If you keep My commandments, you will remain in my love just as I have kept My Father's commandments and remain in His love. I have told you these things so that My joy may be in you and your joy may be complete.

And **be thankful**. Let the **word of Christ dwell in you richly**, **teaching** and **admonishing** one another in all wisdom, **singing** psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Matthew 22:2-14 Those who were invited to the feast would not come. So the king sent his servants out to invite whoever would come. At the time of the supper, the king encountered a man who did **not have on a wedding garment**. Because of his lack of proper clothing he was cast out into outer darkness.

Isaiah 11:1-3 A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a branch will bear fruit. And the Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him. The Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of knowledge and **fear of the Lord** and He will **delight** in the **fear of the Lord**.
