

Feast of Tabernacles

In the Beginning / Moses day / Messiah's Birth & Return / John 7
October 08, 2014

(KJV) **Revelation 22:1-3** And he shewed me **a pure river of water of life**, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there **the tree of life**, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him.

(KJV) **Revelation 21:1-4** And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, **the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them**, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

(AKJV) **Genesis 2:9a** And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the middle of the garden..

(AKJV) **Genesis 2:10** And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from there it was parted, and became into four heads.

(AKJV) **Genesis 3:8,9** And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. And the LORD God called to Adam, and said to him, Where are you?

(AKJV) **Exodus 25:8,9** And let them make me a sanctuary; that **I may dwell among them**. According to all that I show you, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall you make it.

#5521 סֹכֶת sukkah, a hut, tabernacle, tent.

(AKJV) **Genesis 33:17** And Jacob journeyed to Succoth, and built him a house, and made **booths for his cattle**: therefore the name of the place is called Succoth.

(AKJV) **Exodus 35:20-22** And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: and every man that offered, offered an offering of gold unto the LORD.

(AKJV) **Leviticus 23:39,40** Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, you shall keep a feast to the LORD seven days: on the first day shall be a sabbath, and on the eighth day shall be a sabbath. And you shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the LORD God seven days.

(AKJV) **Leviticus 23:41-43** And you shall keep it a feast to the LORD seven days in the year. It shall be a statute forever in your generations: you shall celebrate it in the seventh month. You shall dwelt in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwelt in booths: That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwelt in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

(AKJV) **Deuteronomy 31:10-13** And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the Feast of Tabernacles, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD your God in the place which he shall choose, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the people together, men and women, and children, and your stranger that is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law: And that their children, which have not known any thing, may hear, and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as you live in the land where you go over Jordan to possess it.

(KJV) **Zechariah 14:3,4** Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

(KJV) **Zechariah 14:8,9** And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be. And the Lord shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one Lord, and his name one.

(KJV) **Zechariah 14:16-19** And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to **keep the feast of tabernacles**. And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith the Lord will smite the heathen that come not up to **keep the feast of tabernacles**. This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to **keep the feast of tabernacles**.

(AKJV) **Genesis 10:1** Now these are the generations of the sons of Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth: and unto them were sons born after the flood.

(AKJV) **Genesis 10:32** These are the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.

(AKJV) **Deuteronomy 32:8** When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

(AKJV) **Exodus 1:5** And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt already.

(AKJV) **Exodus 19:6** And you shall be to me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which you shalt speak to the children of Israel.

(JPS) **2Chronicles 5:1a** Thus all the work that Solomon wrought for the house of the LORD was finished.

(JPS) **2Chronicles 5:3** And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto the king at the feast, which was in the seventh month.

(AKJV) **2Chronicles 5:11-14** And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place: (for all the priests that were present were sanctified, and did not then wait by course: Also the Levites which were the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brothers, being arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:) It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endures for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD; So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

(HNV) **John 8:12** Again, therefore, Yeshua spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life."

(HNV) **Luke 1:5** There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest named Zechariah, of the priestly division of Abijah. He had a wife of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elisheva.

(HNV) **Luke 1:8,9** Now it happened, while he executed the priest's office before God in the order of his division, according to the custom of the priest's office, his lot was to enter into the temple of the Lord and burn incense.

(AKJV) **1Chronicles 24:1,2 19** Now these are the divisions of the sons of Aaron. The sons of Aaron; Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar. But Nadab and Abihu died before their father, and had no children: therefore Eleazar and Ithamar executed the priest's office.

(AKJV) **1Chronicles 24:10** The seventh to Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah,

(AKJV) **1Chronicles 24:19** These were the orderings of them in their service to come into the house of the LORD, according to their manner, under Aaron their father, as the LORD God of Israel had commanded him.

(AKJV) **Luke 1:10,11** And the whole multitude of the people were praying without at the time of incense. And there appeared to him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense.

(HNV) **Luke 1:23,24** It happened, when the days of his service were fulfilled, he departed to his house. After these days Elisheva, his wife, conceived, and she hid herself five months,

(HNV) **Luke 1:26** Now in the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee, named Nazareth.

(HNV) **Luke 1:35,36** The angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore also the holy one who is born from you will be called the Son of God. Behold, Elisheva, your relative, also has conceived a son in her old age; and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren.

(HNV) **Luke 1:56** Miriam stayed with her about three months, and then returned to her house.

(AKJV) **Luke 2:6,7** And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

(AKJV) **Psalms 118:14,15a** The LORD is my strength and song, and is become my salvation. The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous:

(AKJV) **Psalms 118:24,25** This is the day which the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Save now, I beseech you, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech you, send now prosperity.

(HNV) **Luke 2:8-11** There were shepherds in the same country staying in the field, and keeping watch by night over their flock. Behold, an angel of the Lord stood by them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. The angel said to them, "Don't be afraid, for behold, I bring you good news **of great joy** which will be to all the people. For there is born to you, this day, in the city of David, a **Savior, who is Messiah the Lord**.

(AKJV) **John 1:14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelled among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

(AKJV) **Luke 2:13** And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

(AKJV) **Exodus 15:2** The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and **I will prepare him an habitation**; my father's God, and I will exalt him.
