(NIV) **John 14:2** My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you?

(NIV) **Isaiah 55:9b** My ways are higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.

(NIV) **Acts 2:2-4a** And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit....

(ERV) **Ezekiel 1:26-28** There was something that looked like a throne on top of the bowl. It was blue like sapphire. There was also something that looked like a man sitting on the throne. I looked at him from his waist up. He looked like hot metal with fire all around him. The light shining around him was like a rainbow in a cloud. It was the Glory of the LORD. As soon as I saw that, I fell to the ground. I bowed with my face to the ground, and then I heard a voice speaking to me.

Hebrews 11:8, 9a, 10 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country...for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God.

John 16:33 Yeshua said: I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

Genesis 18:3-8 And said My Lord, if I have now found favor in Your sight, do not pass on by Your servant. Please let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest your selves under the tree. And I will bring a morsel of bread, that you may refresh your hearts. After that you may pass by inasmuch as you have come to your servant. They said, Do as you have said. So Abraham hurried into the tent to Sarah and said, Quickly, make ready three measures of the fine

meal; knead it and make cakes. And Abraham ran to the herd, took a tender and good calf, gave it to a young man, and he hastened to prepare it.

Matthew 10:40 He who receives you receives Me, and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me.

Matthew 25:35, 38, 40b I was hungry, and you gave Me something to eat; I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink; I was a stranger and you invited Me in. Then the righteous will answer Him saying Lord when did we see You hungry and feed You or thirsty and give You drink? And the King will answer and say to them, Assuredly I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.

Luke 22:26 One who is the greatest among you must become like the youngest, and the leader like the servant.

John 13:3-5 Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God; so he go up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet....

Genesis 18:9-14a Then they said to him Where is Sarah your wife? So he said Here, in the tent. And he said I will certainly return to you according to the time of life, and behold, Sarah your wife shall have a son. (Sarah was listening in the tent door which was behind him.) Now Abraham and Sarah were old, well advanced in age; and Sarah had passed the age of child-bearing. Therefore Sarah laughed within herself saying After I have grown old, shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also? And the LORD said to Abraham, Why did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I surely bear a child, since I am old? Is anything too hard for the LORD?

(AMP) **Isaiah 55:11** So will My word be which goes out of My mouth; It will not return to Me void (useless, without result), without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.

Hebrews 11:11 By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.

(Schottenstein Chumash) **Genesis 21:1** And the LORD (HASHEM) remembered Sarah as He had said; and HASHEM (The LORD) did for Sarah as He had spoken.

Genesis 8:1 Then God remembered Noah and every living thing, and all the animals that were with him in the ark. And God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided.

Genesis 18:16-17 Then the men rose from thee and looked toward Sodom and Abraham went with them to send them on the way. And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing....

NOTES:

Amos 3:7 Surely the sovereign LORD does nothing without revealing his plan to his servants the prophets.

Genesis 18:20-22 And the LORD said, Because the outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grave I will go down now and see whether they have done entirely according to the outcry against it that has come to Me; and if not I will know. The men turned away from there and went toward Sodom, but Abraham still stood before the LORD.

(BSB) **Romans 3:17-19** and the way of peace they have not known; there is no fear of God before their eyes. No we know that whatever the Law says, it says to those who are under the Law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world held accountable to God....

Proverbs 8:13 The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance, and the evil way, and the forward mouth do I hate.

Psalms 36:1 Transgression speaks to the wicked deep in his heart; there is no fear of God before his eyes.

Psalms 10:4 The wicked, in the haughtiness of his countenance does not seek Him. All his thoughts are, There is no God.

Genesis 18:23 Then Abraham came near and said, Would you also destroy the righteous with the wicked?

Genesis 18:32 Then he said, Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak but once more; Suppose ten should be found there? And He said, I will not destroy it for the sake of ten.

Genesis 19:24, 25 then the LORD rained brimstone and fire on Sodom and Gomorrah from the LORD out of the heavens. So He overthrew those cities, all the plain, all the inhabitants of the cities, and what grew on the ground.

Genesis 21:1-6 And the LORD visited Sarah as He had said and the LORD did for Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did for Sarah as He had spoken. For Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age and at the set time of which God had spoken to him. And Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him whom Sarah bore to him – Isaac. No Abraham was one hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him. And Sarah said God has made me laugh and all who hear will laugh with me.

Genesis 22:1-2 Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham, and said to him, Abraham! And he said, Here I am. Then He said, Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.

NOTES:

Genesis 22:3-4 So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. Then on the third day Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off.

Genesis 22:5 And Abraham said to his young men, Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you.

Genesis 15:6 And he (Abraham) believed in the LORD, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

John 3:16 For God so loved the World that he gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.

Genesis 22:18 In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.

Genesis 12:2,3a I will make you a great nation; I will bless you, and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing; I will bless those who bless you....

Romans 11:17 But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, although a wild olive shoot, were grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing root of the olive tree....

Romans 11:18 Do not consider yourself to be superior to those other branches. If you do consider this: You do not support the root but the root supports you!
