(NASB) **Matthew 6:15** But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions.

(NASB) **Genesis 4:3-8** So it came about in the course of time that Cain brought an offering to the Lord of the fruit of the ground. Abel, on his part also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions. And the Lord had regard for Abel and for his offering; but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard. So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell. Then the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? If you do well, will not *your countenance* be lifted up? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it." Cain told Abel his brother. And it came about when they were in the field, that "Cain rose up" against Abel his brother and killed him.

(NASB) **Genesis 21:9-10** Now Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, whom she had borne to Abraham, mocking. Therefore she said to Abraham, "Drive out this maid and her son, for the son of this maid shall not be an heir with MY son Isaac." The matter distressed Abraham greatly because of HIS son.

(NASB) **Genesis 37:3-4** Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his sons, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a varicolored tunic. His brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers; and so they hated him and could not speak to him on friendly terms.

(NASB) **Genesis 37:11** His brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept the saying *in mind*.

(NASB) **Genesis 37:19-20** They said to one another, "Here comes this dreamer! Now then, come and let us kill him and throw him into one of the pits; and we will say, 'A wild beast devoured him.' Then let us see what will become of his dreams!"

(NASB) **Luke 15:13** And not many days later, the younger son gathered everything together and went on a journey into a distant country, and there he squandered his estate with loose living.

(NASB) **Luke 15:29** But he answered and said to his father, 'Look! For so many years I have been serving you and I have never neglected a command of yours; and yet you have never given me a young goat, so that I might celebrate with my friends;

(NASB) **Genesis 32:3-4** Then Jacob sent messengers before him to his brother Esau in the land of Seir, the country of Edom. He also commanded them saying, "Thus you shall say to my lord Esau: 'Thus says your servant Jacob, "I have sojourned with Laban, and stayed until now;

(NASB) **Genesis 27:44-45** Stay with him a few days, until your brother's fury subsides, until your brother's anger against you subsides and he forgets what you did to him. Then I will send and get you from there. Why should I be bereaved of you both in one day?"

Matthew 5:25 Make friends quickly with your opponent... lest the situation escalate. Get even worse??

(NASB) **Genesis 32:5** I have oxen and donkeys and flocks and male and female servants; and I have sent to tell my lord, that I may find favor in your sight."""

(NASB) **Proverbs 22:16** He who oppresses the poor to make more for himself OR who gives to the rich, *will only come to POVERTY.*

NOTES:

(NASB) **Luke 14:12-14** And He also went on to say to the one who had invited Him, “When you give a luncheon or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or rich neighbors, otherwise they may also invite you in return and *that* will be your repayment. But when you give a reception, invite *the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind*, and you will be blessed, since they do not have *the means* to repay you; for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous.

(NASB) **Deuteronomy 15:11** For the poor will never cease *to be* in the land; therefore I command you, saying, ‘You shall freely open your hand to your brother, to your needy and poor in your land.’

(NASB) **John 12:8** For you always have the poor with you, but you do not always have Me.”

Genesis 33:8-9 And Esau said, “What do you mean by all this company which I have met?” And Jacob said, “To find favor in the sight of my lord.” But Esau said, “I have plenty, my brother; let what you have be your own.”

(NASB) **Luke 6:35** But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High; for He Himself is kind to ungrateful and evil *men*.

Strong’s G15, Agathopoieo, Doing “good” here means: something which profits others, could be a gift or blessing.

(NASB) **Genesis 33:11** “Please take my **gift** which has been brought to you, because God has dealt graciously with me and because I have plenty.” Thus he urged Esau and he took *it*.

Strong’s H1293 Beraka means: Gift

(NASB) **Matthew 5:9** “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

(NASB) **Job 25:2** “Dominion and awe belong to Him who establishes peace in His heights.

(NASB) **Psalms 34:14** Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.

(NASB) **Genesis 32:6** The messengers returned to Jacob, saying, “We came to your brother Esau, and FURTHERMORE HE is coming to meet you, and four hundred men are with him.

(YLT) **Genesis 32:6** And the messengers turn back unto Jacob, saying, ‘We came in unto thy brother, unto Esau, and he ALSO is coming to meet thee, and four hundred men with him;’

NOTES:

(NASB) **Genesis 32:7-8** Then Jacob was greatly AFRAID and distressed; and he divided the people who were with him, and the flocks and the herds and the camels, into two companies; for he said, "If Esau comes to the one company and attacks it, then the company which is left will escape."

(NIV) **Joshua 1:9** Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

(NASB) **Matthew 6:34** "So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

(NASB) **Genesis 32:9-10** Jacob said, "O God of my father Abraham and God of my father Isaac, O Lord, who said to me, 'Return to your country and to your relatives, and I will prosper you,' I am unworthy of all the lovingkindness and of all the faithfulness which You have shown to Your servant; for with my staff *only* I crossed this Jordan, and now I have become two companies.

(NASB) **Genesis 32:11-12** Deliver me, I pray, from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau; for I fear him, that he will come and attack me *and* the mothers with the children. For You said, 'I will surely prosper you and make your descendants as the sand of the sea, which is too great to be numbered.'"

(NASB) **Genesis 32:17-20** He commanded the one in front, saying, "When my brother Esau meets you and asks you, saying, 'To whom do you belong, and where are you going, and to whom do these *animals* in front of you belong?' then you shall say, '*These* belong to your servant Jacob; it is a present sent to my lord Esau. And behold, he also is behind us.'" Then he commanded also the second and the third, and all those who followed the droves, saying, "After this manner you shall speak to Esau when you find him; and you shall say, 'Behold, your servant Jacob also is behind us.'" For he said, "I will appease him with the present that goes before me. Then afterward I will see his face; perhaps he will accept me.

(NASB) **Genesis 32:22-25** Now he arose that same night and took his two wives and his two maids and his eleven children, and crossed the ford of the Jabbok. He took them and sent them across the stream. And he sent across whatever he had. Then Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him until daybreak. When he saw that he had not **prevailed** against him, he touched the socket of his thigh; so the socket of Jacob's thigh was dislocated while he wrestled with him.

Strong's H3201 - to prevail, overcome, endure, have power, be able

NOTES:

(NIV) **Hosea 12:2-4** The Lord has a charge to bring against Judah; he will punish Jacob according to his ways and repay him according to his deeds. In the womb he grasped his brother's heel; as a man he struggled with God. He struggled with the angel and **overcame** him;

Strong's G3528: to prevail, overcome, endure, have power, be able, be victor.

(NASB) **Romans 3:4** May it never be! Rather, let God be found true, though every man *be found* a liar, as it is written, "That You may be justified in Your words, And prevail when You are judged."

(NASB) **1 John 4:4** You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.

(NASB) **Revelation 2:26** He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations;

(NASB) **Revelation 3:12** He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.

(NASB) **Revelation 3:21** He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

(NASB) **Revelation 12:11** And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they DID NOT LOVE THEIR LIFE even when faced with death.

(NASB) **2 Corinthians 5:8** we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

(NASB) **Revelation 17:14** These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful."

(NASB) **Revelation 12:17** So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God AND hold to the testimony of Yeshua.

(NIV) **Jeremiah 29:11** For I know the plans I have for YOU," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

NOTES:

(NASB) **Matthew 28:19** Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

(NASB) **John 13:34-35** A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. ³⁵ By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

(NASB) **James 3:5** So also the tongue is a small part of the body, and yet it boasts of great things.

(NASB) **Luke 13:35** Behold, your house is left to you *desolate*; and I say to you, you will not see Me until *the time* comes when you say, ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!’”

(AKJV) **1 Corinthians 13:12** For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

(NASB) **Romans 11:25** For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the “fullness” of the Gentiles has come in;

(NASB) **Romans 11:18-22** do not be arrogant toward the branches; but if you are arrogant, *remember that* it is not you who supports the root, but the root *supports* you. You will say then, “Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in.” Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith. Do not be conceited, but fear; for if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare you, either. Behold then the kindness and severity of God; to those who fell, severity, but to you, God’s kindness, if you continue in His kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off.

(NASB) **2 Timothy 4:7** I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith;

(NASB) **Isaiah 56:4-8** For thus says the Lord, “To the eunuchs who keep My Sabbaths, And choose what pleases Me, And hold fast My covenant, To them I will give in My house and within My walls a memorial, And a name better than that of sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name which will not be cut off. “Also the foreigners who join themselves to the Lord, To minister to Him, and to love the name of the Lord, To be His servants, everyone who keeps from profaning the Sabbath And holds fast My covenant; Even those I will bring to My holy mountain And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; For My house will be called a house of prayer for ALL the peoples.” The Lord God, who gathers the dispersed of Israel, declares, “Yet *others* I will gather to them, to those *already* gathered.”

NOTES:

(NASB) **Leviticus 19:18** You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the sons of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself; I am the Lord.

(NASB) **Mark 12:30-31** and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these.

(NASB) **Genesis 25:9** Then his sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite, facing Mamre,

(NASB) **John 16:33** These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world."
