**Exodus 27:20,21** And **you shall command** the children of Israel, that they bring you pure oil olive beaten for the light, to cause the lamp to **burn always**. **In the tabernacle of the congregation** without the veil, which is before the testimony, **Aaron** and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever to their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.

**Exodus 27:21a** in the tent of meeting,

**Exodus 28:1,2** Bring **Aaron** your brother, and his sons with him, near to you from among the children of Israel, that he may minister to me in the priest's office, even **Aaron**, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, **Aaron's** sons. You shall make holy garments for **Aaron** your brother, for glory and for beauty.

**Deuteronomy 34:5-8** So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: but no man knows of his sepulcher to this day. And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab **thirty days**: so the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

**Joshua 1:1,2** Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you, and all this people, to the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

**Joshua 1:11** Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within three days you shall pass over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God gives you to possess it.

**Joshua 4:19** And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

**Deuteronomy 31:1,2** And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, **I am an hundred and twenty years old this day**; I can no more go out and come in: also the LORD has said to me, You shall not go over this Jordan.

**Exodus 32:32** Yet now, if you will forgive their sin--; and if not, blot me, I pray, **from your book** which you have written.

**Exodus 28:9-12** And you shall take **two onyx stones**, and you shall engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel. Six of their names shall be on one stone, and six of the remaining names on the other stone, according to their birth. With the work of an engraver in stone, like the engravings of a signet, you shall engrave the two stones with the names of the sons of Israel. You shall make them to be set in settings of gold. And you shall put the two stones upon the shoulders of the ephod for stones of memorial to the sons of Israel. **And Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial.**

**Exodus 28:15** "You shall make a breastplate of judgment, the work of the skillful workman; like the work of the ephod you shall make it; of gold, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, you shall make it.

**Exodus 28:21** The stones shall be according to the names of the children of Israel, twelve, according to their names; like the engravings of a signet, everyone according to his name, they shall be for the twelve tribes.

**Exodus 29:38,39** Now this is that which you shall **offer on the altar**; two lambs of the first year **day by day continually**. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning; and the other lamb you shall offer at even:

**Exodus 29:42-46** This shall be a **continual burnt offering** throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: **where I will meet you, to speak there to you**. And **there I will meet** with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by my glory. And I will sanctify the tabernacle of the

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congregation, and the altar: I will sanctify also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their God. And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.

**Exodus 30:7,8** And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: when he dresses the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. And when Aaron lights the lamps at even, he shall burn incense on it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations.

**Leviticus 23:2** Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts (Meeting times) of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.**(Meeting times)**

**Leviticus 23:4** These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.**(times)**

### **PURIM in PROPHECY**

**Exodus 17:13-16** And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword. And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this for a memorial in a book, and rehearse it in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovahnissi: For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.

**Genesis 38:29** And it came to pass, as he drew back his hand, that, behold, his brother came out: and she said, How hast thou broken forth? this breach be upon thee: therefore his name was called Peretz.

**Deuteronomy 25:17,18** Remember what Amalek did unto thee by the way, when ye were come forth out of Egypt; How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, even all that were feeble behind thee, when thou wast faint and weary; and he feared not God.

**Genesis 14:7,8** And they returned, and came to Enmishpat, which is Kadesh, and smote all the country of the Amalekites, and also the Amorites, that dwelt in Hazezontamar. And there went out the king of Sodom, and the king of Gomorrah, and the king of Admah, and the king of Zeboiim, and the king of Bela (the same is Zoar;) and they joined battle with them in the vale of Siddim;

**Genesis 36:12** And Timna was concubine to Eliphaz Esau's son; and she bare to Eliphaz Amalek: these were the sons of Adah Esau's wife.

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**Deuteronomy 13:16-18** The LORD said to Moses, "Behold, you shall sleep with your fathers; and this people will rise up, and play the prostitute after the strange gods of the land, where they go to be among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them. Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall come on them; so that they will say in that day, 'Haven't these evils come on us because our God is not among us?' I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evil which they shall have worked, in that they are turned to other gods.

**Proverbs 25:2** It is the glory of God to conceal a thing, but the glory of kings is to search out a matter.

*The first time is by Memucan (1:20); the second by Esther (5:4); the third by Haman (5:13); the fourth by the inspired writer (7:7).*

20. And when the king's decree, which he shall issue, shall be proclaimed throughout all his kingdom, which is very large, all the wives shall give to their husbands honor, both to great and small.

**1Samuel 15:2,3** Thus says the LORD of Hosts, 'I have marked that which Amalek did to Israel, how he set himself against him in the way, when he came up out of Egypt. Now go and strike Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and don't spare them; but kill both man and woman, infant and nursing baby, ox and sheep, camel and donkey.'

**1Samuel 15:8,9** He took **Agag** the king of the Amalekites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword. But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the cattle, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all that was good, and wouldn't utterly destroy them: but everything that was vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

**1Samuel 15:13,14** Samuel came to Saul; and Saul said to him, "You are blessed by the LORD! I have performed the commandment of the LORD." Samuel said, "Then what does this bleating of the sheep in my ears, and the lowing of the cattle which I hear mean?" Saul said, "They have brought them from the Amalekites; for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the cattle, to sacrifice to the LORD your God. We have utterly destroyed the rest."

**1Samuel 15:15** Saul said, "They have brought them from the Amalekites; for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the cattle, to sacrifice to the LORD your God. We have utterly destroyed the rest."

**1Samuel 15:19-21** Why then didn't you obey the voice of the LORD, but took the spoils, and did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD?" Saul said to Samuel, "But I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. But the people took of the spoil, sheep and cattle, the chief of the devoted things, to sacrifice to the LORD your God in Gilgal."

**1Samuel 15:24,25** Saul said to Samuel, "I have sinned; for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and your words, because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, please pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD."

**1Samuel 15:26-28** Samuel said to Saul, "I will not return with you; for you have rejected the word of the LORD,

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and the LORD has rejected you from being king over Israel.” As Samuel turned about to go away, Saul grabbed the skirt of his robe, and it tore. Samuel said to him, “The LORD has torn the kingdom of Israel from you this day, and has given it to a neighbor of yours who is better than you. Then he said, “I have sinned: yet please honor me now before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and come back with me, that I may worship the LORD your God.”

**1Samuel 9:1,2a** Now there was a man of Benjamin, whose name was Kish, the son of Abiel, the son of Zeror, the son of Becorath, the son of Aphiah, the son of a Benjamite, a mighty man of valor. He had a son, whose name was Saul,

**Esther 2:5** There was a certain Jew in the citadel of Susa, whose name was Mordecai, the son of Jair, the son of Shimei, the son of Kish, a Benjamite,

**Esther 3:10** The king took his ring from his hand, and gave it to Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, the Jews' enemy.

**Genesis 49:21** “Naphtali is a deer let loose, he gives words of elegance.

**Isaiah 52:7** How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!

**Genesis 31:4** Jacob sent and called Rachel and Leah to the field to his flock,

**Deuteronomy 33:23** Of Naphtali he said, “Naphtali, satisfied with favor, full of the blessing of the LORD, Possess the west and the south.”
