Leviticus 9:1,2 And it came to pass on the eighth day, that Moses called Aaron and his sons, and the elders of Israel; and he **said to Aaron**, “Take a calf from the herd for a sin offering, and a ram for a burnt offering, without blemish, and offer them before the LORD.

Leviticus 9:3,4 And to the children of Israel you shall speak, saying, Take you a **kid of the goats for a sin offering**; and a calf and a lamb, both of the first year, without blemish, for a burnt offering; Also a bullock and a ram for peace offerings, to sacrifice before the LORD; and a meat offering mingled with oil: for today the LORD will appear to you.

Leviticus 9:6 And Moses said, This is the thing which the LORD commanded that you should do: and the glory of the LORD shall appear to you.

Leviticus 9:22-24 And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and blessed them, and came down from offering of the sin offering, and the burnt offering, and peace offerings. And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and blessed the people: and **the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people**. And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed on the altar the burnt offering and the fat: which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

Leviticus 10:1,2 And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not. And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Leviticus 16:1,2 The LORD spoke to Moses, after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they drew near before the LORD, and died; and the LORD said to Moses, “Tell Aaron your brother, not to come at all times into the Most Holy Place within the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark; lest he die: for I will appear in the cloud on the mercy seat.

2Samuel 6:5-7 David and all the house of Israel played before the LORD with all kinds of instruments made of fir wood, and with harps, and with stringed instruments, and with tambourines, and with castanets, and with cymbals. When they came to the threshing floor of Nacon, Uzzah reached for the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the cattle stumbled. The anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God struck him there for his error; and there he died by the ark of God.

Leviticus 10:3 Then Moses said to Aaron, This is it that the LORD spoke, saying, I will be sanctified in them that come near me, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his peace.

God has to keep a separation between Himself and us – for our protection!

A human ruler is feared more by his distant subject than by those close to him. It is not so with God, for those close to Him are more awe-stricken than those far removed, as it is stated: “By those who are near unto Me will I be sanctified.”

Amos 3:1,2 Hear this word that the LORD has spoken against you, children of Israel, against the whole family which I brought up out of the land of Egypt, saying: “You only have I chosen of all the families of the earth. Therefore I will punish you for all of your sins.”

Leviticus 10:8-11 And the LORD spoke to Aaron, saying, **Do not drink wine nor strong drink**, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of the congregation, **lest you die**: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations: And that you may put difference between holy and common, and between unclean and clean; And that you may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them by the hand of Moses.

Leviticus 10:12,13 And Moses spoke to Aaron, and to Eleazar and to Ithamar, his sons that were left, Take the **meat offering** that remains of the offerings of the LORD **made by fire, and eat it without leaven** beside the altar: for it **is most holy**: And **you shall eat it in the holy place**, because it is your due, and your sons' due, of the sacrifices of the LORD **made by fire: for so I am commanded**.

Leviticus 6:24-26 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, “Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, ‘This is the law of the sin

offering: in the place where the burnt offering is killed, the sin offering shall be killed before the LORD. It is most holy. The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. It shall be eaten in a holy place, in the court of the Tent of Meeting.

Leviticus 10:16-18 And Moses **diligently sought the goat of the sin offering**, and, behold, it was burnt: and he was angry with Eleazar and Ithamar, the sons of Aaron which were left alive, saying, Why have you not eaten the sin offering in the holy place, seeing **it is most holy**, and God has given it you to bear the iniquity of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD? Behold, the blood of it was not brought in within the holy place: you should indeed have eaten it in the holy place, as I commanded.

Leviticus 10:16a And Moses **diligently sought**

Deuteronomy 4:29 But if from there you shall **seek** the LORD thy God, you shall find him, if you **seek** him with all your heart and with all your soul.

The central message of the Torah is that we must always be inquiring as we search.

2Timothy 2:15 **Study** to show yourself approved to God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly **dividing the word** of truth.

2Timothy 3:15 From infancy, you have known the holy Scriptures which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith, which is in Messiah Yeshua.

John 5:39 **Search** the scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.

2Corinthians 5:21 For he has made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

Luke 24:44,45 And he said to them, These are the words which I spoke to you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, **concerning me**. Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,..

Leviticus 11:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and to Aaron, saying to them, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, **These are the beasts which you shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth.**

NOTES:

Genesis 1:28,29 God blessed them. God said to them, “Be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth, and subdue it. Have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the sky, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” God said, “Behold, I have given you every herb yielding seed, which is on the surface of all the earth, and every tree, which bears fruit yielding seed. It will be your food.”

Genesis 2:16,17 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, “Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it; for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die.”

Genesis 7:2 You shall take seven pairs of every clean animal with you, the male and his female. Of the animals that are not clean, take two, the male and his female.

Genesis 7:3 Also of the birds of the sky, seven and seven, male and female, to keep seed alive on the surface of all the earth.

Genesis 9:1-3 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth. And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be on every beast of the earth, and on every fowl of the air, on all that moves on the earth, and on all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered. Every moving thing that lives shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.

Genesis 9:4 But flesh with its life, its blood, you shall not eat.

Leviticus 11:3 Whatever parts the hoof, and is cloven-footed, and chews the cud among the animals, that you may eat.

Leviticus 11:4-6 Nevertheless these shall you not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the hoof: as the camel, because he chews the cud, but divides not the hoof; he is **unclean** to you. And the coney, because he chews the cud, but divides not the hoof; he is unclean to you. And the hare, because he chews the cud, but divides not the hoof; he is unclean to you.

Deuteronomy 14:21a You shall not eat of anything that dies of itself: you shall **give it to the stranger** that is in your gates, **that he may eat it**; or you **may sell it to an alien**: for you are a **holy** people to the LORD your God.

Matthew 9:20-22 Behold, a woman who had an issue of blood for twelve years came behind him, and touched the fringe of his garment; for she said within herself, “If I just touch his garment, I will be made well.” But Yeshua, turning around and seeing her, said, “Daughter, cheer up! Your faith has made you well.” And the woman was made well from that hour.

NOTES:

Malachi 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings;

Leviticus 11:39,40 “If any animal, of which you may eat, dies; he who touches its carcass shall be unclean until the evening. He who eats of its carcass shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the evening. He also who carries its carcass shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the evening.

Leviticus 11:44,45 For I am the LORD your God: you shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and **you shall be holy; for I am holy:** neither shall you defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creeps on the earth. For I am the LORD that brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: **you shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.**

1Peter 1:15,16 But as he which has called you is holy, so be you holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be you holy; for I am holy.

Ephesians 1:4 According as he has chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him **in love:**

Ephesians 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Leviticus 11:46,47 This is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature that moves in the waters, and of every creature that creeps on the earth: To make a difference between the unclean and the clean, and between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten.

Ezekiel 22:26 Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned my **holy** things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed difference between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

Isaiah 11:6-9 The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice' den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.

Isaiah 65:25 The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the ox; and dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain,” says the LORD.

NOTES:

1John 1:7-9 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Yeshua the Messiah, his Son, **cleanses us** from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us the sins, and to **cleanse us** from all unrighteousness.

Leviticus 13:45 “The leper in whom the plague is shall wear torn clothes, and the hair of his head shall hang loose. He shall cover his upper lip, and shall cry, ‘**Unclean! Unclean!**’

Acts 10:9-15 On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew near to the city, Peter went up on the housetop to pray about the sixth hour: And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: but while they made ready, he fell into a trance, And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending on him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of four-footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and **creeping things**, and fowls of the air. And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat. But Peter said, Not so, Lord; for I have never eaten anything that is **common** <koinos> **or unclean** <akathartos>. And the voice spoke unto him again the second time, **What God has cleansed, that call not you common.** <koinos>

Acts 10:16 This was done **three times**, and immediately the vessel was received up into heaven.

Acts 10:19 While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said to him, Behold, **three men** seek you.

Acts 10:28 And he said to them, You know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation; but **God has showed me that I should not call any man common or unclean.** Not, “Now I can eat spiders, owls, and eagles!” or eat humans!

Romans 14:14 I know, and am persuaded by the Lord Jesus, that there is nothing <koinos> unclean of itself: but to him that esteems anything to be <koinos> unclean, to him it is <koinos> unclean.

Ephesians 1:4 According as he has chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should **be holy and without blame** before him **in love**:

Ephesians 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that **it should be holy** and without blemish.

Luke 1:5,6 There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest named Zechariah, of the priestly division of Abijah. He had a wife of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elisheva. They were both righteous before God, **walking blamelessly in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord.**

2Samuel 6:5-7 And David and all the house of Israel played before the LORD on all manner of instruments made of fir wood, even on harps, and on psalteries, and on tambourines, and on cornets, and on cymbals. And when they came to Nachon's threshing floor, Uzzah put forth his hand to the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook it. And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for his error; and **there he died by the ark of God.**

Matthew 3:16,17 Yeshua, when he was immersed, went up directly from the water: and behold, the heavens were opened to him. He saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming on him. Behold, a voice out of the heavens said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

Psalms 2:12 Give sincere homage to the Son, lest he be angry, and you perish in the way, for his wrath will soon be kindled. Blessed are all those who take refuge in him.

Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended up into heaven, and descended? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has bound the waters in his garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name, if you know?

1Samuel 20:18 Then Jonathan said to him, "Tomorrow is the new moon: and you will be missed, because your seat will be empty."
