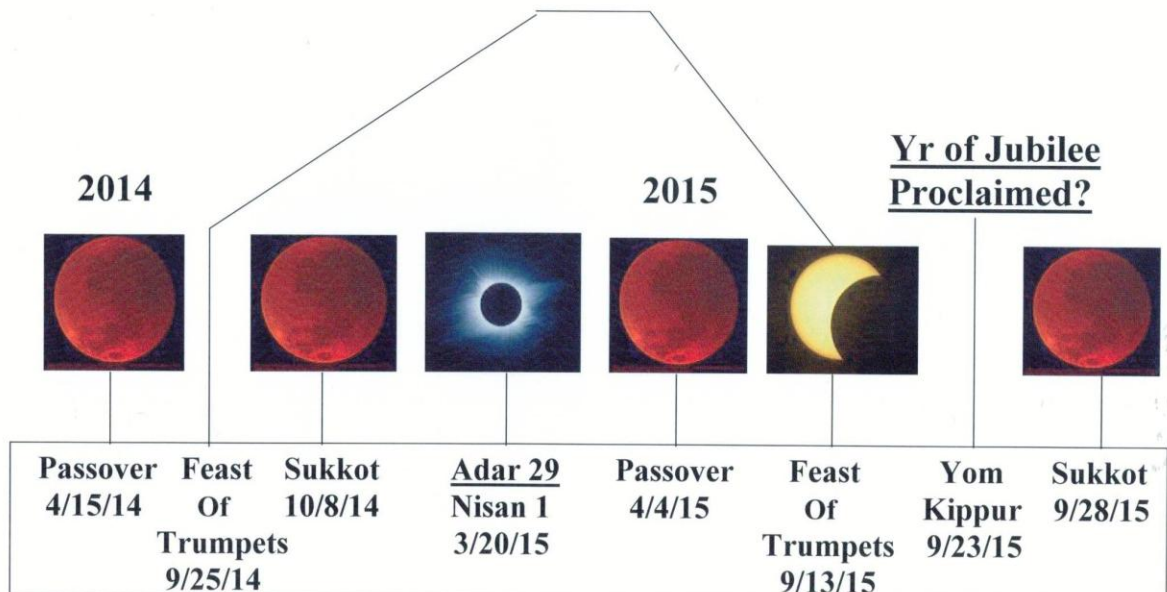

VAYAKHEL (And He Assembled)
Exodus 35-40 / 1Kgs 7:40-8:21 / Mark 15

Building the Kingdom of God/Heaven Here on Earth

Ex 35:1 And Moses assembled <qahal> all the congregation <edah> of the sons of Israel, and saith unto them, ` These are the things which Jehovah hath commanded-
-to do them:

#6950. קהל Kahal to assemble

#5712 עדת edah assembly / congregation

These words are often used interchangeably - Church (the building or the people)

Ac 18:26 And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: <sunagoge>

Jas 2:1,2 My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons. For if there come unto your assembly <sunagoge> a man with a gold ring,

Mt 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; <ekkklesia> and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

G#1577 Ekklesia from G#2564 Kaleo - assembly

Ac 7:37,38 This is that **Moses**, which said unto the **children of Israel**, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear. This is **he, that was in the church** <ekkklesia> **in the wilderness** with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us:

The Greek word <ekkklesia> translated here as church is used all through the "Old Testament" in the Greek translation of it? Edah is translated as <sunagoge>

Ac 19:41 And when he had thus spoken, he dismissed the assembly. <ekkklesia>

1Ki 8:1,2 Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion. And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto king Solomon at the feast in the month Ethanim, which is the seventh month.

Ac 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Messiah was intimately involved with the building of the "house of God" or temple each time.

Ex 35:4,5 And Moses spake unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD commanded, saying, Take ye from among you an offering unto the LORD: whosoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it, an offering of the LORD; gold, and silver, and brass,
(Moses has the plans - They begin during the Feast of Tabernacles!!!

Ex 35:2a Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be to you an holy day, a sabbath of rest to the LORD:

The very first thing Moses establishes at his "second coming" down the mountain with the information on building the tabernacle for God's presence is the Sabbath day. Observing the Sabbath is even more important than building the tabernacle.
"Moses Second Coming" down is on Yom Kippur - the day of Atonement!

When Messiah comes, He also will "assemble" the people:

Mr 13:27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

He will have the plans to rebuild the Temple:

Zec 6:12,13a And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD: Even he shall build the temple of the LORD:

It will be at Sukkot:

Zec 14:4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

Zec 14:16-19 And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles. This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

Sukkot is like the Sabbath of Biblical Festivals. Just as the Sabbath is the seventh day of the week Sukkot is the Seventh Festival of the year in the Seventh month. It is the culmination and completion of the annual festival cycle in the plan of God. Like the Sabbath Day Sukkot is a celebration of the messianic Kingdom on Earth! He will also again reinstitute the Biblical Sabbath as the first order of business because the Sabbath is the picture of the Messianic Age; the 1,000yr Sabbath rest!

Le 23:34-36 Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days to the LORD. On the first day shall be a holy convocation. You shall do no work of labor. **Seven days** you shall offer a fire offering to the LORD. On the eighth day shall be a holy convocation to you. And you shall offer a fire offering to the LORD. It is a solemn assembly. And you shall do no work of labor.

Pr 7:19,20 For the goodman is not at home, he is gone a long journey: He hath taken a bag of money with him, and will come home at the day appointed.

#3677. כֶּסֶף kece', The full moon, i.e. its festival:--(time) appointed.

Ge 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs <'owth>, and for seasons <mow`ed>, and for days <yowm>, and years <shaneh>:

0226. אֹת 'owth, probably from 225 (in the sense of appearing, to come); a signal (literally or figuratively), as a flag, beacon, monument, omen, prodigy, evidence, etc.:--mark, miracle, (en-)sign, token.

4150. מוֹעֵד mow`ed, properly, an appointment, i.e. a fixed time or season; specifically, a festival;

Joe 2:31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come.

(There will be a total solar eclipse and a total lunar eclipse before the great and terrible day of the Lord.) (A watch vs a warning)

1Th 5:1-6 But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness. Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.

Mt 2:2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? For we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.

Isa 61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

Re 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

Re 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

1260 days / 3.5 = 360 days

Da 9:25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

7 x 7 = 49 years = 7 weeks of years leading up to a Jubilee year.

June 7th 1967 Jerusalem was restored to Israel and began to be built up in troublous times!

49 prophetic years x 360 days = 17,640 days.

So let's count from June 7th 1967 forward, to the day, 17,640 days and see where it takes us!
